The Services of the Yearly Cycle


The yearly cycle is dedicated to the Saints of every day of the year. The most significant are the services of the twelve Great Feast Days of Christ and the Virgin Mary, Theotokos. They are:

- 1. The Nativity of Christ (Christmas, December 25)
- 2. The Epiphany (Baptism of Christ, Theophania), including the Sanctification of Waters (Jan. 6).
- 3. The Transfiguration of Christ (in anticipation of His Resurrection, August 6).
- 4. The Entrance of Christ into Jerusalem (Palm Sunday).
- 5. The Ascension of Christ (40 days after Pascha).
- 6. The Pentecost (50th day after Pascha, the Descent of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles).
- 7. The Exaltation of the Holy and Life-giving Cross (finding of the Cross, September 14).
- 8. The Nativity of the Virgin Mary, Theotokos (September 8).
- 9. The Presentation of the Virgin Mary, Theotokos, in the Temple (November 21).
- 10. The Annunciation of the Virgin Mary, Theotokos (Angel's announcement of her conception by the Holy Spirit, March 25).
- 11. The Presentation of the Christ Child in the Temple (February 2).
- 12. The Dormition (Repose) of the Virgin Mary, Theotokos (August 15).

The Services of the Weekly Cycle

The weekly cycle consists of services for each day of the week. Sunday is dedicated to the Resurrection; Monday to the honor of the Holy Angels; Tuesday to the memory of the prophets, especially to John the Baptist; Wednesday to the Cross; Thursday to the memory of the Saints; Friday to the Crucifixion; Saturday to the Saints and especially to the Virgin Mary, Theotokos, and to all who have died in the hope of resurrection and eternal life. These weekly services are repeated every eight weeks according to the Tone of the Week, which is eight complete sets of hymns, prayers and lessons for every day of the week. A different Tone is sung during each of eight consecutive weeks, and then the cycle starts over again.
